

# Ways to dispose of garbage and recyclables

Leave garbage out between 6 am and 8 am on the collection day. Please keep the garbage pickup station clean.

Garbage to be collected  
at the garbage pickup station

## Combustible garbage

- Use a Nakai Town designated Combustible garbage bag. ● Cut large and long items down to 30 cm or smaller. ● Maximum 5 videotapes per collection. ● Dispose of *futon* (bedding) as oversized garbage.
- ◎ Kitchen waste
  - Please drain all liquid completely.
- ◎ Plastic products
  - Dispose of items with a ♻️ mark as plastic containers and packages
- ◎ Diapers
- ◎ Razors and disposable lighters
- ◎ Leather products
- ◎ Shoes
- ◎ Unrecyclable paper waste
  - Tissues, oiled paper, thermal paper, photo paper, carbon paper, paper stained with food/oil, synthetic paper, etc.

## Non-combustible garbage

- Items 50 cm or larger are oversized garbage. ● Put sheet glass and glassware in a transparent bag for collection.
- ◎ Pots, kettles, frying pans, and other metal cookware
- ◎ Large cans, etc.
  - Empty the contents.
  - Be sure to empty the contents and do not puncture them.
- ◎ Umbrellas
  - Remove material and dispose as combustible garbage.
- ◎ Small electric appliances
  - Cut off power cables and dispose as non-combustible garbage.
- ◎ Breakables and ceramics
- ◎ Metal toys
- ◎ Spray cans

## Cans

- Up to about 20 cm
- Remove from bags and put in the designated container for cans.
- ◎ Empty cans
  - Empty the contents and wash before disposing.

## Bottles

- Wash and dispose of in the designated containers which are separated into 3 colors as follows.
- Be sure to remove bottle caps and dispose as non-combustible garbage.
- Dispose of sheet glass and glass tableware in a transparent bag as non-combustible garbage.
- Transparent
- Brown
- Other colors

## Harmful waste

- Dispose of batteries in the battery collection box.
- Dispose of fluorescent lights and light bulbs in orange container.
- ◎ Batteries
- ◎ Fluorescent lights and light bulbs

## PET bottles

- Remove caps and labels and wash inside of bottles.
- Dispose of caps and labels as plastic containers and packages.
- Do not crush or cut.

## Plastic containers and packages

- Apply to all items with the plastic cartons and packages ♻️ mark.
- Wash and wipe any stains off. Dispose of items with stickers or stains as combustible garbage.
- Crush large styrofoam and put in a bag.
- ◎ Tubes and caps
- ◎ Bottles
- ◎ Trays
- ◎ Cups and packages
- ◎ Plastic bags and cling wrap
- ◎ Styrofoam

## Used paper and fabric

- ◆ Newspapers, fliers, magazines and books
- ◆ Miscellaneous (cardboard and paper boxes, milk containers, other paper, clothing and fabrics)
- ◎ Newspapers and fliers
- ◎ Magazines and books
- ◎ Cardboard boxes and paper boxes
- ◎ Milk containers
- ◎ Other paper (wrapping paper, paper bags, copy paper, postcards, etc.)
  - Keep them in a paper bag and tie to prevent scattering.
- \* Foreign matter, which cannot be recycled as paper (dispose as combustible garbage)
  - Do not mix the following items with other paper.
  - Envelopes with adhesives and press-sealed postcards (confidential postcards)
  - Waterproof paper (paper cups/plates)
  - Oiled paper, photographs, and gold/silver foil-stamped paper
  - Synthetic paper (made of plastic which is not paper to be exact)
  - Textile printing paper (ironing print paper)
  - Thermal paper (fax paper, receipts, etc.)
  - Thermosensitive formed sheet (e.g. braille form paper which rises when heated)
  - Carbon paper, pressure sensitive copy paper (courier waybills, etc.)
  - Composite material paper (paper bonded with plastic film, etc.)
  - Paper with scent (wrapping paper for soaps, washing detergent boxes, etc.)
- ◎ Clothing and fabrics
  - T-shirts and underwear
  - Trousers
  - Jackets
  - Skirts
  - Sweaters
  - Socks
  - Leather jackets
  - Blankets
  - Towels
  - Padded items such as *futon* (bedding), *hanten* (padded roomwear), and down jackets are not recyclable. Dispose of *futons* as oversized garbage. Dispose of others as combustible garbage after cutting into pieces smaller than 30 cm.
  - Make sure to wash clothing and put in a transparent bag.

## Pruned branches

- Use Nakai Town free collection service for pruned branches from households or farms. Branches will be shredded into wood chips and reused as a resource.
- Collectable branches: maximum diameter up to 18 cm, length up to 130 cm.
- Collectable trunks: maximum diameter up to 50 cm, length up to 60 cm.
- Toxic or rotten trees cannot be collected.
- Individual collection day is every Tuesday and direct carry-in day is every Friday. For bookings, contact the Industry and Environment Division (81-1115) no later than noon before the collection or carry-in date.
- Trim small branches and leaves

## Oversized garbage

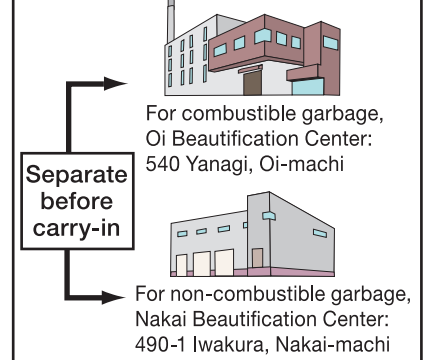
- Combustible garbage larger than 30 cm and non-combustible garbage larger than 50 cm are considered oversized garbage. They are not to be placed at the garbage pickup station. Please carry in directly at Eastern Seiso Kumiai or apply individual collection.
- Both direct carry-in and individual collection require prior applications.
- Individual collection is available, up to 3 items once per month, ¥1,000 + tax per item.
- The 4th Friday of the month is individual collection day. For bookings, contact the Industry and Environment Division by the 3rd Friday of the month.

## Direct carry-in garbage

Large amount of garbage or oversized garbage from household moves and major housecleaning can be accepted by direct carry-in at Eastern Ashigara Seiso Kumiai.

- Carry-in time:
  - Weekdays 9:00 to 11:00 / 13:00 to 16:00
  - Saturdays 9:00 to 11:00
  - \*The 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month only
  - \*Not open on public holidays
- Fees: Up to 10 kg ¥250
- Over 10 kg, ¥250 for every 10 kg

Please call to book carry-in no later than the day before.



## Air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, and dryers

- Request collection using one of the methods below:
  1. Request a pickup from the retailer where it was purchased
  2. Request collection from a permitted collection business
  3. Carry in directly to a collection facility
  4. Apply the individual collection for oversized garbage. Collection fee is ¥2,000 + tax.
- Using either method, transfer the recycling fee at a post office and receive an Electric Appliances Recycling Ticket and a Certificate of Payment slip for money transfer.
- Attach the Certificate to the Ticket, then stick it on the item's top-right area.

## PC equipment

- (Main bodies of desktop computers, Laptop computers, LCD and CRT display monitors)
- The town does not provide collection service. Please "request collection from PC manufacturers" or "use a package delivery service for collection."
- Collection by PC manufacturers
  - Under the "Act on the Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources," manufacturers collect and recycle items with a recycling mark.
  - For items that do not have a recycling mark, self-made PCs, etc., please contact the PC3R Promotion Association. PC3R Promotion Association Tel. 03-5282-7685
- Collection by package delivery service
  - Please apply directly to the town's contracted recycling company, ReNet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd.
  - Applications can also be made online or by fax. For more information, please visit the town's website.

## Items forbidden for disposal

- Cannot process at Nakai Town. Sell back to the retailer or ask a special processor.
- ◎ Fire extinguishers
- ◎ Tatami mats
- ◎ Concrete blocks
- ◎ Car batteries
- ◎ Pianos
- ◎ Medical waste
- Industrial waste, tatami mats, fire extinguishers, propane gas cylinders, tires, car batteries, pianos, organs, agricultural instruments, agrichemicals, medical waste, paint, oil, blocks, construction waste materials, bath tubs, motorcycles, scooters, etc.
